

Weberek Water Project – East Timor

Weberek is a small remote village that is located in East Timor a couple of hours drive from Same.

Weberek has a population of approx 100 families. This small community is not only remote but very, very poor. Several years ago Indonesian authorities came to the village and took away the village's water pump and generator. Now the people of Weberek have to walk 3 hours to find water once their wells dry up. This lack of water has compounded problems in the community in areas such as agriculture and sanitation.

ARMS has been approached by the people of Weberek to help them restore their water supply.

Over the next 18 months ARMS aims to;

- Assess the water problems of Weberek.
- Restore full water supply to the village.
- Establish a Primary Health Care project in the village.
- Assist with establishment of other community development program in the village.

We estimate that over these projects will cost the following;

- Water assessment - \$10,000
- Water Restoration Project \$30,000
- Primary Health Care and Agricultural Projects \$25,000
- Other Community development projects - \$35,000
